In Kyrgyzstan, bread is not just food, but also an important symbol representing hospitality and respect. There are many traditions, customs and stories connected to bread, as well as many different types of bread and styles of baking. In this bread-making tour, you'll have the opportunity to enjoy the bread baking process up close in a local bakery and learn some of the stories and legends about bread.

Get hands on with local bakers and learn how to work the dough, and to shape and decorate your own mai tokoch, a local Uighur-style bread round. Then, watch as a local baker arranges the dough rounds insides a traditional tandyr (clay, wood-fired oven) and bakes it all to perfection. Finally, enjoy a hearty breakfast with bread straight from the oven served with kaimak (local sour cream), homemade jams and tea. This activity is great for adults and kids. We guarantee you a breakfast experience you'll never forget!
